Parental Informed Consent and Hold Harmless/Release Agreement

I, the undersigned parent or legal guardian, understand that River Camp will be conducted in an outdoor and public environment, which involves a certain degree of risk. I have carefully considered the risks involved and have given consent for my child to participate in the activities associated with River Camp. I understand that participation in these activities is entirely voluntary and requires participants to abide by applicable rules and standards of conduct. I do hereby release Mandarin Museum & Historical Society, Inc. (MMHS), the employees, volunteers, board members, or other organizations associated with the activities from any and all liability, cost, or expense associated with any injury sustained by any member of my family while participating in MMHS's programs.

In case of emergency involving my child, I understand that every effort will be made to contact the individual listed as the emergency contact person. In the event that this person cannot be reached, permission is hereby given to the medical provider selected by adult leaders in charge to secure proper treatment for my child. Furthermore, the undersigned agrees that in the event that medical attention is required due to accident or illness, MMHS shall be permitted to seek such medical services as it shall deem necessary and appropriate through Emergency Medical Attention, 911 and/or local hospitals and the undersigned will be responsible for all expenses of such care. MMHS will not administer any medications without written instructions and parental signature.

Tuition Refund

Tuition reserves a child's place in a camp session and allows the museum to purchase supplies and hire staff. Tuition is due in full to reserve your spot. At the Mandarin Museum & Historical Society's (MMHS) discretion, camp tuition may be refunded up to two weeks before the beginning of a session. No tuition can be refunded for cancellation less than two weeks from the beginning of a session. The MMHS reserves the right to cancel a session if not enough participants register. If a session is cancelled, participants will receive a full refund.

Personal Attire and Supplies

River Camp is held in an outdoor environment and proper attire and personal supplies are key for safety and comfort. **Closed toe shoes are required** for participation. It is suggested that participants bring two pairs, one for dry activities and one for wet activities. It is suggested that participants also have light-weight, long sleeve pants and shirts for protection against insects and the sun. It is also suggested that participants have a spare set of clothes. **Participants must also provide their own sunscreen and bug repellent.** It is suggested that participants have their own hand sanitizer.

Lunch

Participants must provide their own lunch, including beverages. We will provide a snacks and water during the course of the day. Be advised that there is no refrigeration on premises. **Participants must have a refillable water bottle every day.**

Behavior Policy

Violence or aggressive behavior will **NOT** be tolerated. This includes, but is not limited to: threatening behavior, destructiveness, inappropriate language, verbal or written threats, harassment, verbal abuse, and physical abuse. Participants who exhibits inappropriate behavior will be immediately suspended for the day and parents contacted. If inappropriate behavior persists, the participant will be expelled from the camp and will not be allowed to participate until the following summer. All camp fees are non-refundable once a session has begun.
